## AMBLERS WALK - SATURDAY 14<sup>th</sup> October Around the Piethorn valley reservoirs



The October walk visits an area of reservoirs, hills and the hamlets of Higher and Lower Ogden, near Newhey, south of Milnrow. Most of the walk is on tracks which wind up and over the hills above the reservoirs, with lovely wide ranging views over the South Pennine Moors if the weather is good. There are no stiles but there could be a few wet or muddy bits if there has been recent rain. Bring warm and waterproof / windproof clothing, good footwear and a drink. Meet in the car park at St. Andrew's ready to depart at 9.30. We travel to Ogden Reservoir where there are toilets and free car parking; we should be ready to start walking by 10.30. Most of the uphill is in the first half of the walk, steady rather than too steep. The walk is only 4 miles and should take only about 2 hours, but there are enough ups and downs to make us feel well exercised. You can return home straight after the walk (but check first if you will need a lift) or we can enjoy rest and refreshment / lunch at the Bull's Head at Lower Ogden, or find a spot to eat a sandwich. 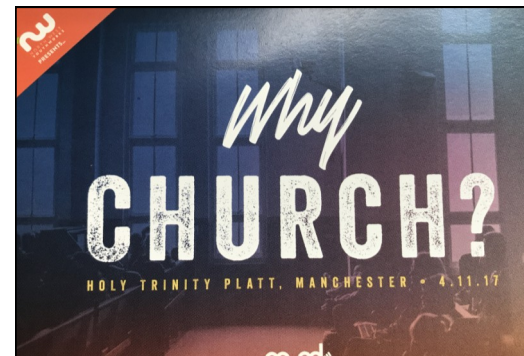
