AMBLERS WALK SATURDAY 10 FEBRUARY

Our next trip is a visit to Bollington with a walk up to White Nancy and along Kerridge Ridge as the highlight. The walk is suitable for all ages and is 5.5 miles in length.

We drive to the Ranger carpark at Bollington and park there for free. This is a straightforward walk with the climb up to White Nancy, and the last part of the Ridge up to the trig point, being the only uphill parts. The rest of the walk takes in a canal towpath, part of the Middlewood Way plus several interesting field excursions. The recent wet weather has created an awful lot of mud and extremely wet fields so waterproof boots are an absolute must. It might also be useful to wear gaiters if you possess them. All the usual wet weather clothing is also recommended. Poles are also recommended to cope with the mud...

We shall leave St Andrews car park at 09.30 and the walk should finish by 13.30. Please bring a snack and drink for our mid-morning stop. After the walk there is the option to visit the nearby Vale Inn for lunch, where food is served all day. There are toilets at the car park.
